Dr Armstrong recommends the following screening procedures during an annual woman's health examination:

1. Vaginal sonogram - this study has the best chance of identifying ovarian cancer (often called the "silent killer") at a very early stage. Most ovarian cancer does not exhibit symptoms until the cancer is in an advanced stage.
2. Colposcopy - this additional component of your vaginal exam provides additional screening for cervical cancer. Even with a Pap smear (which will also be completed), studies show that 20% of cervical cancers can still be missed. If you no longer have a uterus/cervix, this examination will not be done.

Most insurances cover this exam and procedure; however every insurance is unique and we cannot guarantee it will be covered. In addition, if you have a high deductible plan, this may apply to your deductible.
